Prompt use of a defibrillator could help save the life of a person suffering from cardiac arrest.

Defibrillator 1 is located in Jack King Drive, on the building wall near to the electric gate Security hut.

Defibrillator 2 is located in Jack King Drive, on the Sandy Bay office front wall. Security have code to gain access in an emergency.

The committee now consists of twelve residents, assisted by Associate Members who provide specialist support as required. Elections are held yearly to select new members or re-elect existing members standing again.

The aims and objective of the SBPRA are firstly to promote residents' rights in respect of the maintenance and improvement of their living conditions, amenities, environment and to act in the interests of all residents and members.
