# **Community drop-in**

The next community drop-in will be held on 26 September 2024, 3pm-6pm.

## **Progress from site**

Over the past month we have:

- Opened the landside revetment between Thorney Bay / Labworth Café.
- Installed the new wider floodgate at Fisherman's Corner.
- Completed the Fisherman's Corner access ramp.
- Completed the installation of a temporary Bailey Bridge at the St. Anne's Pumping station to allow unhindered construction traffic movement along the upper haul road.
- Continued removal of Upper/Lower Haul Roads and ramps in Chapman Sands phase.
- Continued the placement of OSA/ LSA in Eastern Esplanade phase.
- Commenced placement of steel reinforcement to the Chapman Sands access ramps.

Reinstating the foreshore area

In the coming months, we will:

- Continue the placement of OSA/LSA in Eastern Esplanade phase.
- Continue with the construction of the temporary upper haul road along Eastern Esplanade and move into the Concord Beach phase.
- Commence construction works local to Concord Café.
- We will be reinstating our compound in the Moviestarr car park from 4th September. We are working with the owner of the Moviestarr and Castle Point Borough Council to reinstate the same free parking arrangements in place over winter 2023/24.
- Continue with the Chapman Sands access ramps.

# Fisherman's Corner ramp: now open



The ramp located at Fisherman's Corner has now been completed and is open to the public. The ramp now allows continued access from Thorney Bay up to the Fantasy Island amusement area. We would like to thank everyone in the area for their cooperation and patience while we carried out the works. Please note that we will need to temporarily close the ramp at Fisherman's Corner at the end of September for a protective coating application to ensure the longevity of the ramp. Signage will be in place to guide pedestrians along alternative routes.

#### Flood and Coast award win

This area still requires ongoing care and attention, and the progress is being diligently monitored by the project team. We are now focussing our efforts on managing weeds and maintaining soil health. This will ensure the continued growth and vitality of the new grass.

#### Riverside closures

There will be a number of local riverside closures in September and October for a research and development trial of concrete coating products for the recently installed riverside materials.

These closures are essential for the application of innovative concrete coating products on the newly installed steps. This initiative is part of a research and development trial aimed at enhancing the durability of public infrastructure.

We will provide further details when they are available.

## Use of drones during the project

Please note that we use drones across the project. The uses of the drones include capturing visual data for pre-condition surveys and as built surveys and capturing progress on site.

All our drone operators (pilots) are trained, Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) registered, and comply with all requirements for commercial use which vary according to the size and weight of the drone.
