The next community drop-in will be held on 26 September 2024, 3pm-6pm.


The session will be held close to the entrance of Kismet Park and will give you the chance to ask the team any questions that you have about the project. You are welcome to arrive at any time between 3pm-6pm.

Progress from site

Over the past month we have:

- Made excellent progress in Chapman Sands phase placing OSA and LSA and now moving into Eastern Esplanade phase.
- Undertook final concrete pour to Fisherman's Corner Ramp.
- Cut down piles / removed piling matt at Chapman Sands ramp.
- Installed the Eastern Esplanade temporary Upper Haul Road and Ramps, including installation of a Bailey Bridge.
- Sown wild-flower grass mix to reinstated landside embankment.
- Continued removal of Satellite Compound 1 at Fisherman's Corner in preparation for handing area back late July.








Reinstatement Fisherman's Corner compound

In the coming months, we will:

- The landside revetment between Thorney Bay and Labworth Café will be opened to public towards end of July.
- The new Fisherman's Corner Ramp, with new floodgate, will be completed and opened to the public end of July / early August.
- Continue with the removal of the temporary Upper/Lower Haul Roads and ramps in Chapman Sands phase.
- Continue the placement of OSA/ LSA in Eastern Esplanade phase.


Sustainability focus: Benfleet Yacht Club reuse timber

We have encouraged the use of sustainable solutions since the start of the project.

The Benfleet Yacht Club has received timber from the Chapman Sands jetty which was dismantled in March this year. The club now plans to use the timber for blocks and supports for the boats at the yacht club.

A Benfleet Yacht Club spokesperson said: "Many thanks for organising this, it is much appreciated and will be put to good use."



Concord Beach footpath route

We are carrying out preparatory and repair works to the revetment, and this means we need to make changes to the coastal path and riverside walkways for a period of time.

This map provides the diversion route (in blue) leading to the riverside. It emphasises the importance of following the designated safe crossing points to continue your journey.

Use of drones during the project

Please note that we use drones across the project. The uses of the drones include capturing visual data for pre-condition surveys and as built surveys and capturing progress on site.

All our drone operators (pilots) are trained, Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) registered, and comply with all requirements for commercial use which vary according to the size and weight of the drone.
